## Leadership Roles

Dr Burgess chairs the Thrombosis Multidisciplinary Team meeting and the local Thrombosis Committee, overseeing the development and implementation of anticoagulation and thrombosis management pathways. He has driven service improvement initiatives through guideline development, incident review and quality assurance projects, notably authoring a regional thrombophilia testing guideline and a regional thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura (TTP) management guideline that have become benchmarks for evidence-based practice. Dr Burgess is also Principal Investigator (PI) for the Thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura registry.
