## Clinical Summary

Mr Galloway is a Consultant General Surgeon at Wythenshawe Hospital, part of the Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust where he was also the Clinical Director for Surgery for 12 years.

He has clinical interests in oesophagogastric disease, hernia surgery, gallstone disease and emergency surgical conditions.

## Medico-Legal Experience

Mr Galloway has been undertaking medicolegal work since 2008 relating to his area of expertise (general and oesophago-gastric surgery). He has attended Medicolegal Expert Witness courses in Leeds, Manchester and London most recently in November 2016.

He writes reports for both claimants and defendants on an equal basis and currently produce approximately 40 reports per year (predominantly causation and liability reports), and would normally prepare reports within 2 months of receipt of instructions.


